TRANSPORTATION: PRIVATE TRANSFER

You will be greeted by your private driver at the Arrivals Hall of the airport after you have cleared customs, collected your baggage, and was taken by luxury vehicle to your hotel.

DAY WALKING TOUR: AMSTERDAM + CANAL CRUISE (4 HOURS)

You'll embark on a walking tour with your private guide and explore this unique city and its main sites. Stroll alongside the beautiful canals towards the late 19th century Amsterdam Central designed by Dutch architect Pierre Cuypers. Please take a brief daytime walk through part of the infamous Red Light District, which can come across as relaxed during the day, quite a contrast to its notorious evening buzz. Continue to Spui Square, where you'll be able to access the gorgeous medieval courtyard known as Begijnhof. Next, view the 1602 Old Man's House Gate, which leads to a covered alleyway with a unique secondhand book market. You will also see the National

Monument to the victims of WWII on route to the iconic Dam Square and the 17th century Royal Palace. At the end of your tour, you'll board a shared boat for a leisurely 90-minute cruise along the canals, one of the best ways to take in the city.

DINNER RESERVATION: SENSES

Senses is a warm and intimate restaurant in the city centre of Amsterdam, with an open kitchen where 'food art' that ignites the senses is created. Chef Lars Bertelsen specializes in creating unconventional menus, which highlight the culinary artistry of the chef and his team. His menus all tell a story and contain unexpected combinations. Choose from the weekly alternating 4 to 7-course surprise menu and embark on your own voyage of discovery. HALF-DAY PRIVATE TOUR: PRIVATE DUTCH WINDMILLS CYCLING TOUR AND CHEESE TASTING (5 HRS)

Explore the famously quaint landscape of the Dutch countryside with a private bike tour from Amsterdam. Escape the city to cycle among historic manor houses, windmills, and canals, while your guide shares details of rural Holland's background and culture. Your day begins with a short drive to the starting point just outside Amsterdam, while your guide provides an overview of the landscape. Upon arrival, you will gear up and start biking in the picturesque surroundings on relatively easy routes. You will be captivated as you pedal past traditional windmills, which Holland is so famous for, and country mansions built as summer residences of Amsterdam's wealthy families during the 17th and 18th centuries. You'll visit a 15th-century farm that specializes in cheese-making. Here you will see how the process works and, best of all, sample all the cheese! Enjoy a traditional picnic lunch, including a variety of Dutch cheeses, local produce, and fresh bread from organic flour ground in a nearby mill.

OPTIONAL: HEINEKEN EXPERIENCE

Hosted in a historic former brewery on the outskirts of Amsterdam's city center, the Heineken Experience offers insight into the history and heritage of Heineken beer. With your admission, enjoy an interactive, self-guided journey through the brewing past, discovering how Heineken transitioned from its humble beginnings as a small Dutch brewery, to what it has become today, one of the world's most iconic and popular beers. ATTRACTION: VAN GOGH MUSEUM

Make your way to Amsterdam's world-famous Van Gogh Museum, a celebration of famed 19th-century Dutch post-impressionist painter Vincent Van Gogh. Your included admission ticket grants you access to view highlighted works of the most extensive Van Gogh collection in the world, spanning the various creative phases of his life. Witness famous pieces from his days in the Netherlands, like Avenue of Poplars in Autumn (1884), The Potato Eaters (1885), and Skull of a Skeleton with Burning Cigarette (1886), to his days in France, with Wheat Field with a Lark (1887), The Yellow House (1888), and Wheatfield with Crows (1890). Many self-portraits are also on display, offering a glimpse into the mind of this misunderstood creative genius.

HALF-DAY PRIVATE TOUR: GOURMET WALKING TOUR + TASTINGS (4 HOURS)

Today you will discover Amsterdam's trendy Jordaan neighborhood for a private guided food-based walking tour away from the touristy areas of the city center. Jordaan is known for its 17th-century architecture and high concentration of quirky cafes, restaurants, and gourmet shops, making it the perfect environment to indulge in local flavors. Your knowledgeable food guide will treat you to various tastings of well-known, top-quality Dutch delicacies at unique places where the locals go. As you walk through Jordaan, from one tasting to another, you'll learn about Amsterdam's history and culture through the fascinating stories behind the Dutch food. Be sure to come with a good appetite because you'll be spoiled with lots of delectable food. *The Tastings will replace lunch today.*
