TRANSPORTATION: PRIVATE TRANSFER

You will be greeted by your private driver at the Arrivals Hall of the airport after you have cleared customs, collected your baggage, and was taken by luxury vehicle to your hotel.

PRIVATE TOUR: HISTORICAL WALKING TOUR (3 HOURS)

At the turn-of-the-century, Berlin was a booming metropolis left bankrupt by WWI. It led the way in avant-garde Art, literature, and music throughout the Roaring Twenties, before Hitler's rise to power made the city the infamous capital of the Nazi Regime. Today, gain a deep insight into Berlin's tumultuous past, on this private guided walking tour. Hear stories surrounding the last days of the Third Reich and Hitler's notorious underground bunker. Learn about the atrocities of the holocaust and visit the memorial dedicated to its victims. Visit Brandenburg Gate where, in June of 1987, President Ronald Reagan famously called on Soviet Premier Mikhail Gorbachev to "tear down this wall!". The city was divided by the Allies after WWII and became the last frontier of the Cold War. It marked by the physical and ideological barrier of the Berlin Wall, which cut through the

center of the city until its fall in 1989. End your tour today with dinner at Restaurant Nolle where marble, mirrors, leather furnishings, and Art déco paintings recreate the charm of late 1920s Berlin.

DINNER RESERVATION: RESTAURANT NOLLE

Experience Berlin as it was and as it is today. The 1920s atmosphere and the historic railway arches invite you to a small journey in time. The menu offers you a fine selection of meals that vary from typical Berlin dishes to international specialties.

HALF-DAY PRIVATE TOUR: ART WALK WITH A LOCAL HISTORIAN (3 HOURS)

On this walking tour, you will explore the districts of Hackesche Hoefe and Prenzlauer Berg with a local art historian as your guide. Both areas were built a century ago as residential dwellings for workers and the lower class. Today, these areas are bustling with life, Art, fashion, and culinary discoveries. These tenement blocks also house famous courtyards home to secret cafes, surprising green oases, hidden ballrooms, art galleries, beer gardens, and a variety of secluded places. Learn more about the daily life of Berlin, its social problems as well as its famous nightlife. Find out where to get typical German sausages and where all the popular local breweries are!

OPTIONAL: MUSEUM PASS

The Berlin museum gives you access to over 30 museums. It entitles you to free entry on three consecutive days, and you can go from one exciting exhibition to the next. The museums on Museum Island, with all their extraordinary masterpieces, are included in the museum pass.

DAY THREE

FULL DAY TOUR: POTSDAM TOUR + TRACK 17 MEMORIAL + SANSSOUCI PALACE (6 HOURS)

Set out on a tour of Potsdam with a private guide and vehicle, beginning with a brief orientation on the way as your guide introduces you to this picturesque city, which features the Brandenburg Gate of Potsdam, the Hunter's Gate, the Dutch Quarter and Russian Colony. On route visit the heart-wrenching Track 17 Memorial where, from 1941 to 1945, Jewish residents of Berlin were deported, initially to ghettos and later to concentration camps. Changing focus, you will visit the famous palace in Potsdam, Sanssouci, which was commissioned by Frederick the Great of Prussia in 1740 in ornate Regal Rococo. Take a stroll through the grounds where you'll wander past elaborate statues and fountains, beautiful gardens, and explore the Chinese Teahouse, which has a collection of both Berlin and Meissen porcelain. On the other side of the park, you will find the New Palace, grander, and more elaborately furnished than the Sanssouci, making for a beautiful end to an incredible tour. Before heading back to Berlin, stop at La Maison Du Chocolat, this historical café in the Dutch Quarter, which serves the best desserts in Potsdam!
