DAY ONE

TRANSPORTATION: PRIVATE TRANSFER

You will be greeted by your private driver at the Arrivals Hall of the airport after you have cleared customs, collected your baggage, and was taken by luxury vehicle to your hotel.

PRIVATE TOUR: GUIDED WALKING TOUR OF TREVI + PIAZZA NAVONA + PANTHEON (3 HOURS)

Meet your guide at the hotel lobby to begin your walking tour. You will enjoy strolling through the fascinating ancient city of Rome with its quaint little squares and monumental fountains hidden at the end of narrow walkways or behind Rome's many corners. The most famous fountain would be Trevi, where thousands of tourists flock to see every year. The old tradition says tossing a coin over your shoulder into the fountain will ensure a safe return to Rome. Two coins will bring you, love. The fountain is now swept every day, collecting hundreds of Euro, which are then given to charities. Continue to the Piazza Navona, the ruins of the ancient stadium of emperor Domitian that held a

staggering 30,000 spectators to view athletic contests and chariot races. It is lined with comfortable cafes and Baroque palaces and is the home to the Fountain of the Four Rivers, which was designed in 1651 by Gian Lorenzo Bernini for Pope Innocent X. An obelisk from Egypt can also be seen and was formerly in the Circus of Maxentius, but later moved to Piazza Navona. A modern piazza is a lively place where locals and tourists like to spend sunny afternoons sipping coffee while artists gather in the square to paint. You will also see the temple of all the gods, Rome's Pantheon, which was built between 118-125 AD by Emperor Hadrian. Converted into a church by early Christians, this marvel of architecture is the best-preserved building of ancient Rome and is surrounded by a beautiful and lively piazza. You may choose to end your tour here and have lunch in one of the many surrounding restaurants or have your guide walk you back to your hotel.

DINNER RESERVATION: EPIRO

This restaurant opened on a tucked-away corner of San Giovanni back in 2013 and has been popular from the start. With a focus on natural wines and a selection of shareable plates made with foraged ingredients, this contemporary is sure to satisfy any palette.

HALF-DAY PRIVATE TOUR: VATICAN CITY TOUR + VATICAN MUSEUMS (4 HOURS)

After meeting your guide at your hotel, you will set out on a cultural journey to the center of Christianity; the Vatican. This papal enclave is located within Rome and is the smallest sovereign state in the world by both area and population. You will be taken aback by the remarkable collection of fine art and sculptures as you visit the Vatican Museum and the 15th century Sistine Chapel, viewing paintings by great artistic masters, including Michelangelo's iconic painting the *Creation of the World*, which dominates the chapel ceiling. You'll also visit the Baroque and Renaissance-inspired wonder that is the 17th century St. Peter's Basilica. Constructed over 100 years, St. Peter's Basilica is by far the largest and most renowned Catholic Church in the World. Conclude your tour with a return transfer by private vehicle.

DINNER: PRIVATE FOOD TOUR OF TRASTEVERE (3 HOURS)

Eat and drink in Rome's bohemian neighborhood of Trastevere, known for being home to one-of-a-kind and unique cafes and shops with an incendiary vibe. This is where Romans come to relax and unwind, which of course, means drink and eat. There are hidden gems serving the typical food of Rome, the bold 'Cucina Romana'. Your private guide will help you navigate and understand the complexities of Italian food as there is much more to this gastronomic scene other than beloved pasta. This tour is sure to introduce you to Rome's best dishes, all to be paired with local wine. Try local delicacies such as steaming suppli or fried artichokes. Once you've had your fill of exploring this beautiful neighborhood on foot, it is time to turn into a romantic restaurant for an elegant dinner.

FULL DAY TOUR: PRIVATE OLIVE OIL TASTING + TUSCAN SCENIC DRIVE (5 HOURS)

Meet your guide at your hotel and set out on a private excursion, perfect for those who would like to combine history and the culinary arts. Take in the flavors of Etruscan Italy and enjoy the taste of homemade Italian products while visiting a farmhouse located in the beautiful countryside of Tuscania. This region was the cradle of the Etruscan civilization, thus pre-dating the Roman Empire; evidence of this mysterious culture remains in the form of decorated tombs. You'll arrive in the village, which stands at the top of a rocky hill overlooking the Maremma region where Etruscan and Renaissance buildings have been lovingly restored to reflect the history. Take a walk with your guide through the narrow cobblestone lanes of this charming village and admire the views of the surrounding valleys.

Leaving Tuscania, you will proceed to a local family-owned farmhouse that produces olive oil, vegetables, jams, and local products. Upon arrival, gain insight into the history of olive oil production and enjoy a sampling of different oils with typical bruschetta bread, tomatoes, homemade jam, and honey, all accompanied by local wine and liquors. Relax before your return journey to Rome.
